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## REBECKAH FIELDS AND HER CLAYTON AND RASH FAMILIES

Rebeckah Fields ( 1801/1805 KY - after 1870, probably in Bond twp of Lawrence Co, IL) was a typical pioneer farmer's wife who helped convert the unbroken forests into farms and homes. Her parents are not yet known, but she was probably born to a frontier Field or Fields family in or near Bourbon Co, KY. There were few schools in her youth, and she never learned to read nor write. She did learn what was necessary to survive, as she mothered two families of children of her own and took care of others left homeless.

No record has been found of her marriage in or near Bourbon Co, KY, to George P. Clayton( 1790/1800 KY - c 1838 Crawford Co, IL) son of

Their first son was born in Bourbon Co, Ky, in 1825, but they soon moved into the timberland of Crawford Co, IL, in the Wabash and Embarrass River basins and developed a farm in what today is in Montgomery township. They lived there until George P. died, and had at least 8 ch, but names of only five are known -- Samuel T.; Elizabeth; Price; William; and Minerva. Three daughters born before 1830 had probably md by 1850. A great grand-daughter believed the surnames Heath and Tennyson were in the family, and these names were in the communities where Rebeckah lived. Another possible family name was Shelton.

After George P. Clayton died, Rebeckah (Fields) Clayton md (2) on 9 July 1840 in Crawford Co, to a widower with a family, William Rash ( 1800 KY - after 1870, probably in Bond twp of Lawrence Co, IL) son of

William and Rebeckah had three Rash ch: Stephen; Amos; and James Milton. After 1850 and before 1860, Rebeckah and William moved their family across the county line into Bond twp of Lawrence Co. Apparently there was considerable movement as several of their 1850 neighbors in Crawford Co, were also their 1860 neighbors in Lawrence Co. Most of what we know about the families of Rebeckah comes from census records and the biographies of son Samuel T. Clayton of Green Co, WI, and of Samuel T. Lindsay of Crawford Co, IL. Civil War records may be helpful when they are located.  
Ch:

a. Samuel Thomas CLAYTON (22 June 1825 Bourbon Co, KY - 17 Feb 1890 Green Co, WI) was an infant when his parents moved to Crawford Co, IL. After his father died when he was 14 and his mother remarried, he went to adjacent Lawrence Co. In 1843 he md Elizabeth Altaline Simmons, dau of Dempsey and Mary (Moore) Simmons of NC and IL. They lived in Lawrence Co at first, then moved to Green Co, WI, where Samuel worked as a miner and teamster. They returned to Lawrence Co, IL, in the early 1850's, then settled permanently in Green Co, WI, as farmers. Ch were Mary E.;

Sarah C.; Henry C.; George P.; Elizabeth; Nancy Annette; Samuel T.; William D.; Myrtle; and Rebecka J.

b. Elizabeth CLAYTON (26 Feb 1831 Crawford Co, IL - alive in 1883) md John T. Lindsay (28 Jan 1825 Ripley Co, IN - alive in 1883) probably son of Hazael and Sally Lindsay. They lived in Montgomery twp of Crawford Co, and their ch incl Leander; Samuel T.; Amos; Sally A.; Nathaniel F.; Martha; Susan; Mary; Viola; and twins Minnie and Edward. Samuel T. was Sheriff of Crawford Co in 1880, then he was a farmer and teacher. Nathaniel F. was a teacher and later a medical doctor in Lawrence Co. Amos was a farmer in Crawford Co. Leander was not found on census records after 1860.

c. Minerva CLAYTON ( 1832 IL )  
was with her mother and stepfather in 1850. She had likely md by 1860.

d. Price CLAYTON ( 1835/36 IL )  
was double listed in 1850, once with Richard and Louisa Richards, possible relatives, and with his mother and step-father William Rash. He was not found later, but in 1880 in Washington twp of Green Co, WI, a Price Clayton (1861 IL) was with a Gill family.

e. William CLAYTON ( 1838 IL - )  
In 1850, he was with his brother in Green Co, WI. In 1860, he was back in Montgomery twp of Crawford Co, IL md to Bethelda (1843 TN) along with a child Ellen Y. Carnes (1856 IL). In 1870 he was in Lawrence Co, IL with his RASH half-brothers, and next to his mother. His wife was shown as Jane (1843 TN), and their ch were Joseph (1860 IL); Emaline (1862); Mary (1865); Samuel (1867); and Lilly (1870). In 1880, Lilly was with her cousin, Sheriff Samuel T. Lindsay in Crawford Co. The others have not been located after 1870.

William Rash probably had children in the area from a previous marriage, and two are tentatively identified. One William Rash lived in 1860 in Crawford Co, near where William and Rebeckah had lived in 1850. In 1860, one Susan Rash (1833 KY) was with William and Rebeckah as an idiotic adult. Rebeckah's RASH ch were:

i. Stephen J. RASH ( May 1841 IL - after 1900, probably in Lawrence Co, IL) md (1) Mahaly (1845 IL) and lived in 1870 in Bond twp with dau Nancy (1868 IL) and another possible step-child, George Ford (1861 IL). (Ford families were neighbors to Rebeckah both in Crawford and Lawrence counties). By 1880, Stephen's wife was Mrs. Ellen Berry (1856 NC) and added ch were

Vietta (1875) and Laura M. (May 1879), and step daus Anna Berry (1871) and Mattie Berry (1874). By 1900 there was an additional son, Ansby W. (Feb 1886). Stephen J. may have been the last surviving child of Rebeckah.

j. Amos RASH ( 1843 IL - not listed 1900 )  
md Evaline E. (Feb 1851 IL) and ch were Samuel  
(Dec 1867); Ida B. (1869); Anna J. (1871); James H. (1873);  
William H. (July 1874); Alice (1878); Clara (Aug 1879); Ira E.  
(Feb 1884); Cora O. (Aug 1886); Leonard (Nov 1889); and  
Stella M. (Aug 1893). Amos was in Lawrence Co in 1870, Jefferson  
Co in 1880, and his family was in Wayne Co in 1900.

k. James "Milton" RASH ( 1845 IL - **not listed** 1900 )  
md Mary S. (Aug 1846 IN) and live in Lawrence Co. In  
1870, his aged parents lived with their grandchild Ellen Rash  
(1862 IL) in his household. Milton's ch were Sarah (1866);  
Seraphim (1867); Alta M. (1869); Martha J. (1872); Emma B. (1875);  
Hersheal (Nov 1878); Harrison (May 1882); Lizzie (Feb 1884); and  
Napoleon (Jan 1886). The widow and her younger ch were still in  
Bond twp in 1900.

l. In 1850 and 1860, an apparent granddaughter Mary E.  
Shelton (1849 IL) was with William and Rebeckah. She could have  
bee#either William's or Rebeckah's granddaughter from their first  
marriages. In 1870, the Ellen Rash with them could have been  
Milton's dau, but she was listed after her grandparents.

(There were several Field and Fields families in Bourbon Co, Ky,  
in 1800 and 1810, and some had females in the age bracket for  
Rebeckah Fields.)

George P. Clayton and Rebeckah (Fields) of KY and IL;  
(Biography of son Samuel T. Clayton indicates he was born in  
Bourbon, Co, Ky in 1825. No Claytons were indexed for Bourbon co  
for 1820, but Samuel Clayton had been in the county in 1800 and  
1810. In 1810, he showed a large household, 13201-20101, which  
could include George P. The initial P. may have meant Price, as  
one son and a probable grandson wereso named.)

engaged in farming. In 1847, he removed to Crawford County, Ill., and purchased a farm of 120 acres, in Licking Township, which he improved and sold and purchased another farm in the township, of 300 acres, mostly improved land, on which he had good buildings and an excellent orchard. In 1871, he removed to Robinson, and soon after engaged in the farm implement business, purchasing a residence in town. He has a family of six children—William J., Mrs. Caroline M. Newlin, Mary, Emma, Lillie and Stephen A. D.

G. W. LEWIS, manager Co-operative Company's store, Robinson, was born April 5, 1835, in Montgomery County, Penn.; his father, who was a physician, removed to Carroll County, Ohio, when subject was very small, and when he was four years old his father died. The family soon after removed to Columbiana County, Ohio, where he made his home until 1870, when he came to Crawford County, Ill., and engaged in farming, in Hutsonville Township, on a farm of 200 acres, which he still owns. Having had several years' experience in merchandising in Ohio, he, in 1877, took the position of manager of the Co-operative Company's store in Robinson, and after one year returned to the farm, but was recalled by the stock-holders of the store, and has held the position of manager ever since. He was married in 1859 to Miss Elizabeth Calvin, a daughter of Robert Calvin. They have six children living—Mrs. Jeanette J. Brown, Douglas A., Armando W., Clement L., John V., and Pietro L.

AMUEL T. LINDSAY, photographer, Robinson, was born in Crawford County, Ill., January 20, 1847, and is a son of John T. and Elizabeth (Clayton) Lindsay, both of whom are living, he born in Versailles, Ripley County, Ind., January 28, 1825; she

born in Crawford County, Ill., February 26, 1831. Subject was raised on a farm in Montgomery Township and engaged in teaching and farming alternately. In 1879, he was elected Sheriff by the Republican party, and served in that capacity two years. After his term of office had expired, he engaged in his present business. In September, 1882, he was burned out, but has rebuilt and restored his business. In Montgomery Township, Crawford County, Ill., in 1867, he married Mary E. Harris, born in New Hebron, Crawford County, Ill., November 11, 1848, daughter of William and Elizabeth (Roar) Harris; he, a native of Virginia, born December 17, 1817, died April 14, 1855; she a native of North Carolina, born November 30, 1824, and is still living.

AUSBY L. LOWE, Deputy Circuit Clerk, Robinson, is a son of Isaac N. and Amanda (Hurst) Lowe, and was born in the town of Hutsonville, this county, November 18, 1857. He grew to manhood with such facilities for education as the town afforded, until in 1877, when he entered Earlham College, at Richmond, Ind., and there completed his education. Upon leaving school he became Deputy Circuit Clerk of Crawford County, which position he has satisfactorily filled ever since. From childhood, Ausby has practiced the strictest honor and integrity, and is to-day, what may be termed in the full sense of the term, an honest man. He was married November 20, 1879, to Miss Alice C. Hodge, of York, Ill. The result of this union is one child—A. Lyman, born August 18, 1880. Politically, Mr. Lowe is a Democrat of the old Jackson school.

HOWARD B. LUTES, clothing merchant, Robinson, is a native of Indiana, and was born in Jacksonboro, December 23, 1850, and at the age of fifteen he entered the State University at Bloomington, remaining there
