ABOUT OUR ANCESTORS

By James V. Harris

It is not difficult for Mr. Harris of Ohio, Indiana, Kentucky, Virginia, West Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Tennessee to trace his ancestral lineage to the "First Ancestor" in America. The "first" was Capt. Thomas Harris, born in Wales in 1587, and who came to Virginia Colony in 1611. Another interesting item is that John Washington, the Great-Grandfather of George, the "Father of His Country," and who came to America in 1657, married the Grand-Daughter of Capt. Harris.

Is it not a matter of interest to you, Mr. Harris, to establish your lineage? Can you trace back to Capt. Thomas Harris? Especially should it be interesting and helpful to those of you who desire fraternal connections with some Colonial organization to be able to go back to either Capt. Harris or Mr. John Washington.

Capt. Thomas Harris was a Charter member of the Virginia Company and came to America with Sir Thomas Dale in 1611. For six years Capt. Harris was a member of the House or House of Burgesses. His children were Maj. William, also a member of the House of Burgesses from Charles City County in 1657; and Thomas and Mary. Major William married Mary Carleton. To this union were born seven sons: Stephen, William, David, Nathan, Henry, John and Joel; and seven daughters, Mary, Rebecca, Catherine, Celia, Martha, Louise and Cynthia.

From Joel Harris, of this family, came the many descendants of the Harris family throughout the states of Georgia, Florida,
