② Around 1791 the Mays were settling on the headwaters of the Cumberland and Kentucky Rivers and then came to the Big Sandy Region.

③ Floyd County, the 40th of the Counties of Kentucky in order of formation, was established by an act of the General Assembly of Kentucky in 1799, out of parts of Fleming, Montgomery + Mason Counties.

④ In 1810, John May and Caleb May were listed as taxpayers in Floyd County also Samuel May and William Mays.
