## **Safety Tips**

- · Always wear gloves when handling magnets to prevent pinching and to protect against rope burns and rusted or sharp metal
- Children should NOT be allowed to play with strong neodymium magnets. Keep away from power outlets to prevent electric
- · Keep magnets at least 20cm away from sensitive electronic and storage devices (mechanical watches, heart pacemakers, CRT monitors and televisions, credit cards, data storage media, etc).
- · Avoid the collision of magnets.
- Don't use magnets in places where they are exposed to extreme
- · Consider wearing safety goggles when handling large magnets.
- · Keep grappling hook away from eyes and face
