Safety Tips

- Always wear gloves when handling magnets to prevent pinching and to protect against rope burns and rusted or sharp metal edges.
- Children should NOT be allowed to play with strong neodymium magnets. Keep away from power outlets to prevent electric shocks.
- Keep magnets at least 20cm away from sensitive electronic and storage devices (mechanical watches, heart pacemakers, CRT monitors and televisions, credit cards, data storage media, etc).
- Avoid the collision of magnets.
- Don't use magnets in places where they are exposed to extreme heat.
- Consider wearing safety goggles when handling large magnets.
- Keep grappling hook away from eyes and face
