
## Toniebox makes listening easy.

#### Using the Toniebox is so simple:

## **Turning On**

Press one of the ears with your thumb and forefinger or place the box on its charging station.





## Playing and pausing

When the light on your Toniebox turns green, place a Tonie on top. Want to pause the story or song? Just remove the Tonie from the Toniebox. When you place your Tonie back on, it will pick back up from the same spot as long as another Tonie hasn't been played in between.





## Turning the volume up and down

Press the big ear to turn up the volume on the Toniebox. Use the little ear to turn it down.




## Skip back and forth

To skip back and forth between chapters, tap your Toniebox on its side. To fast-forward or reward, tilt the box to one side.

## **Charging your Toniebox**


Even a Toniebox needs a little rest and relaxation sometimes. The LED will glow green when the battery is sufficiently charged. The LED lights up orange when the battery is low.



## **LED Display Overview**

The Toniebox has different LED indicators. Here's a brief overview:

Color	LED Display Meaning
Flashing green	Factory setting: Please install
Green light	Everything's good to go. The battery is sufficiently charged and the Toniebox is ready to play.
Pulsing blue	The Toniebox is in connection mode and can now look for new wireless internet connections.
Flashing blue	This may mean the following:  a. The Toniebox is connected to the internet and is downloading new Tonie content.  b. The Toniebox is looking for available wireless internet connections before it switches into connection mode (lasts approximately 20 seconds).
Orange light	Warning — low battery! Place your Toniebox on the charging station to recharge the battery.
Red light	Oops! An error has occurred. Your Toniebox will tell you which error it is in a voice message.
White light	Offline mode

#### **Battery notice**

The batteries in the device, which allow the portable use of the Toniebox are not removable. Replacement of the batteries by the user is therefore not permitted. Opening the box will void the warranty.

#### Safety instructions

Please note that the Toniebox is an audio device with complicated technology inside. The Toniebox is designed for use at home and is not splash- or drip-proof. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to excess moisture or immerse it in water.

#### Safety instructions for using the charger

△ CAUTION: The charger consists of the AC adapter and the charging station. The Toniebox should only be operated with the charger provided (included in the starter set), which is a special adapter for toys. Misuse of the charger may result in an electric shock. The charger must not be cleaned with liquids. The Toniebox must be disconnected from the charger before cleaning. The charger is not a toy and should therefore only be used by adults. The charging station is a passive component and is only to be used with the Toniebox. As with all electric products, precautions should be observed during handling and use to prevent electric shock. Little footprints left by the Tonies on the top of the box can be removed with a plain-colored eraser. After that you can clean the area with a damp microfiber cloth.
